Our mission at Meadowlark Elementary is to know the student, know their needs, show growth - ALL in everyday!

**Monday:** If you are looking for skills to practice at home, we have learned all the letters and sounds. We have learned the high frequency words: the, I, and a, is, do, to, of, and said, to, do, see, me, he, be, from, look, book, and are, was, you, what, have, your, want, go, so, no, goes, says, she, we, wish, they, their, that, them, then, and this, were, with, talk, walk, much, and such. We are also learning how to make and read words with the letters such as map, sat, pat, fat, am, as, tap. **We are also learning how to write simple sentences using the sounds we hear on our own as well as practicing to spell the heart words correctly when we write the sentences. Those sentences should also start with a capital letter, end with a period, and have spaces between the words. The students should know how to count to at least 75 and should be working their way to 100 on their own and solve simple addition problems that equal 5 or less.** The students should also be able to identify the numerals 0 to 20. **We will learn the words could, would, should, when, and which this week. We will be reviewing shapes, addition, and subtraction this week.**
