We are also learning how to make and read words with the letters such as map, sat, pat, fat, am, as, tap. **We are also learning how to write simple sentences using the sounds we hear on our own as well as practicing to spell the heart words correctly when we write the sentences. Those sentences should also start with a capital letter, end with a period, and have spaces between the words. The students should know how to count to at least 75 on their own and solve simple addition problems that equal 5 or less.** We will continue numbers to 20 in math. We will be learning the words your and want this week.
